The Docks Professional Facilities Engineer (Civil option) is a permanent full time position with the AL Port Authority in Mobile, AL in the state merit system. This is supervisory and professional civil engineering work involving the marine cargo terminals and facilities at the Port of Mobile and inland waterways.

Employees are responsible for planning and administering various phases of engineering work in the location, design, construction, maintenance, repairs, and upgrades of a variety of dock, warehouse, and cargo handling facilities. Serves as project manager to assure civil engineering and construction activities yield a safe and quality operational product within budget and allotted time.

Minimum Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering.
- Possession of a Professional Engineer's License issued by the AL Board for the Registration of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors.
- Four years of technical and administrative work experience in engineering and maintenance, railway construction, plant and dock construction, or other engineering maintenance activities.
- Valid AL Driver's license
- Ability to obtain a Transportation Worker's Identification Credentials Card
