General Information and Instructions Regarding the Reporting Requirements for Contractors Awarded an Exemption Certificate

A contractor's exemption certificate for a Government Entity project is needed in order to purchase materials tax exempt for the qualified project. Once the exemption certificate has been applied for and awarded, there is a monthly filing requirement to report the purchases that have been made for each exempt project. The Consumer's Use (CNU) tax account is used to report the tax-exempt purchases made with each certificate for each exempt project for each month.

The consumer's use tax return must be filed for each of the months covered by the exemption certificate. (For example, if the certificate's effective date is June 29, 2014 and the expected completion date is October 1, 2014, a consumer's use tax return must be filed for each of the following months: June, July, August, September, and October.) A return MUST be filed each month to report the monthly purchases. Therefore, all active exemption certificates must be included on the monthly report even if the monthly purchases for a specific project was \$0.

If a CNU tax account is not already open under the taxpayer/business name, one will automatically be assigned at the time the exemption certificate is generated. Electronic filing is required through the Department's online filing system, My Alabama Taxes (MAT). A letter containing the online filing information will be mailed to the address on file within a few days after the new CNU tax account has been assigned. This letter will contain all the information needed to create your online filing account in MAT. For questions relating to setting up the account on www.myalabamataxes.alabama.gov, please contact Business Registration at 334-242-1584 or the Sales Tax Division at 1-866-576-6531.

Once the MAT account is set up, please log in and file the monthly CNU tax return. There is a table located at the bottom left hand corner labeled "Contractor's Exemption for Government Construction Projects." All three fields in the table are required to be completed: exemption number, project number, and total amount of purchases for that specific project for the month. Additional projects may be added on the additional rows that appear as data is added; the table will allow the addition of more projects.

***Please do not use lines 1 through 9 of the return for reporting exempt project information. Leave these lines blank unless taxable purchases were made outside of the state of Alabama that need to be reported and tax remitted. (Lines 1 through 9 do not have anything to do with the exemption reporting requirements).

When the certificate expires (upon the project's completion) and the CNU tax account is no longer needed, please contact the Business Registration Unit at 334-242-1584 and close the CNU tax account. Please be advised that if there are multiple government entity projects open, the consumer's use tax account should remain open until the last project completion date. For example, if Project EXC00ABCD ends in June of 2014 but Project EXC00EFGH ends January of 2015, the CNU tax account must remain open until the end of January 2015. A return for Project EXC00EFGH must be filed all the way through January 2015.

If the applicant already has a CNU tax account and it is currently set up online, please use this account to report exempt project purchases through www.myalabamataxes.alabama.gov using the instructions provided above. The return may then be filed as usual.

***All Consumer's Use Tax returns are due on the 20th of the month following the month in which purchases were made (i.e., the return for the month of June is due July 20th, etc. There are 20 days to file the return before it is deemed late.)

***Any penalty waiver requests may be directed to the Sales and Use Tax Division at 1-866-576-6531. Only one waiver per 18 month period is allowed.

General, All sheet piles: ZZ sections can be used in lieu of AZ sections of same size.

DS-07, Demolition Details: On Detail 1, revise the following note "Portion of existing 90 LB A.R.A rail series B, to be removed and stored by contractor and given to ASPA for their future use."

MA-10, Return Wall Elevation: AZ 19-700 sheets piles are 65ft long sheets and AZ 12-770 sheet piles are 60ft long sheets.

MA-11, Return Wall Typical Sections: The existing rail to be removed will not be replaced. The concrete approach slab and precast rail sections on Detail 1 is not required. The concrete slab on Detail 2 is not required. Refer to attached typical asphalt pavement detail for their replacement.

U-03, Utility Details - Section 3: Delete in its entirety.

Response to RFIs

- 1. Is the section of track to be removed and reinstalled in concrete or asphalt? *Response: The track will be removed in order to install the new wall but will not be reinstalled.*
- 2. You are asking to reuse the existing 90# rail and place it in a old castle tub crossing panel. There are only 2 manufacturers that make this type of crossing panels and neither one makes a 90# tub the smallest either one makes is 100# or 115#. Changing rail size is normally not a problem if the track is on ballast but being encased in concrete on the existing panels will cause one. Would you consider using a double ended gauge spaced every 2' and then do a cast in place concrete? *Response: Not required, reinstalling the rail has been removed from the project.*
- 3. Will any of the three tracks have to be left in service while work is done on the other tracks? *Response: No, the tracks are out of service.*
- 4. Furthest north track has girder rail, what size is this rail. *Response: Not applicable as reinstalling rail is no longer in the project.*
- 5. Section 100 Item 100-07 states payment for stored materials will not be accepted on projects that are tax exempt. Can you please confirm this is correct? *Response: ASPA will pay for stored sheet piles only upon delivery to the site and verification by the Owner or EOR that the materials meet the project specifications. The schedule of prices has been revised to separate sheet pile material and installation.*

Contractor shall submit material procurement invoices with all pay applications for stored sheet piles.

- 6. Will the contractor or owner be responsible for the cost of the testing laboratory? *Response: Contractor is responsible for all third-party testing.*
- 7. Section 31 41 16 Item 3.03A states "The contractor is responsible for transporting and stockpiling of the sheet pile on a barge for access from water."; however, Section 01 52 00 Item 3.10A states that "Staging on the Pier shall be limited to the Relieving Platform only. No Staging on the pier outside of the Reliving Platform is allowed. Construction access to the site shall be limited to the existing Relieving Platform and by barge." Please confirm that the contractor can transport the sheet piles by truck and store them on the relieving platform.

Response: The relieving platform is rated for a vehicular live load of an HL-93 truck and 500 psf uniform load where no voids exist underneath. Existing warehouse doors must be accessible at all times.

- 8. In the body of the bid bond form on page I-7, it has the project # as 10532 and the task as 03, which does not correlate with the project # or task shown on the title page. Will a new bid bond form be issued for submission? *Response: Yes, see attached*
- 9. For the rails that need to be removed and replaced at bent 1, are the existing rails intended to be reused or will this be new material? *Response: Reinstalling rails has been removed from the project. The existing rails shall be removed, stored, and given to the ASPA.*
- 10. Can the 270 Calendar Day duration be extended to allow sufficient time to order the sheet piles based on today's market conditions with materials? *Response: Yes, the time is extended to a 365-calendar day duration.*
- 11. Can ASPA provide a new coating specification? 48 mils exceed the coating manufactures maximum thickness *Response: Yes, reduce each coat to 20 mils for a total of 40 mil DFT.*
- 12. Please confirm the construction equipment weight restrictions on the existing relieving platform *Response: Refer to response 9*



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- 13. Due to the amount sheet pile material on the project and our market's current violate condition concerning material will ASPA be able to release the Notice To Proceed within 5-7 days in order for the contractor to order the sheet piles? *Response: ASPA will make every effort to issue the Notice of Intent to Award to the winning bidder within 7 days of the bid opening, however the NTP can't be issued until the Contractor provides all documents required by the NOIA.*
- 14. Can ASPA provide Rail & Utility contractors that are/have worked in the facility? *Response: Rail installation has been removed from the project. ASPA cannot provide a list of potential utility contractors.*
- 15. Detail 1 on sheet MA-08 shows armoring and sealing the new edge of pavement with a L3x3x1/4" with nelson studs, backer rod, and sealant. Detail 3 on MA-07 shows the steel angle inset into the new pavement and existing pavement. Please confirm that the steel angle will only be required on the edge of the new pavement. Response: Detail 1/MA-08 is in the direction of the new wall length and is only required in the new concrete slab and the detail reference indicates similar "SIM". Detail 3/MA-07 is for new joints perpendicular to the wall and requires the angle on both sides of the joint.
- 16. Will both flowable fill and 5000 PSI designs submitted need to be accompanied with a valid ALDOT approved BMT-75? *Response: As this is not an ALDOT project, their actual form does not have to be used, but the information on the form "Identification of Materials" and "Concrete Mix Design" has to be submitted with appropriate manufacturer's certifications.*
- 17. Can you also tell us what the load rating is on the existing pier structure? *Response: Refer to response 9 for the relieving platform. There is no load rating for the existing pier.*
- 18. Is the timber bulkhead missing at the entire length of the void? *Response: The majority is, but not all.*
- 19. In the void area, will we be able to weld angle/plate to the sheet piles to support the concrete cap on the side closest to the water? If so, will that steel have to be coated? *Response: Yes, and it will need to be coated along with the welds.*
- 20. Will we be allowed to demo the timber bulkhead down to bottom of cap before the new wall is installed?

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Response: At contractor's option. Any loss of material behind the new wall will have to be replaced with flowable fill at no additional cost to ASPA during the project.

21. DWG MA-08 Section 1 calls for 1,000 psi high density foam. Is this correct? Do you have a list of approved manufacturers and/or products? *Response: Yes, that is correct. The foam can be custom cut to any size at the plant. Below are a few manufactures, but any can be used that meet the specifications.*

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- 25. The specifications call for the sheet piles to be coated with 48 mils DFT with each coat being 24 mils. Per Carboline Product Data Sheet, the maximum mils is 20 per coat. Please confirm the required mils per coat. *Response: Refer to response 13*
- 26. Provide an elevation of existing utility lines that are to be cut and reinstalled after sheet pile installation. *Response: The elevation of utilities range from 3.5ft to 7.33ft. Refer to existing drawings.*
- 27. Based on sequence the sequence shown on DWG DS-01, the timber bulkhead shall be cut off after the sheet piles are installed which leaves approximately 2" of clearance between the existing bulkhead and the new sheet piles.
