All painting and shop preparation shall be performed in accordance with SSPC (Structural Steel Painting Council) and their manual identified as Volume 2, Systems and Specifications, latest edition, and the paint manufacturer's recommendations. In the event of a conflict, Alabama State Port Authority shall be notified, and the stricter requirement shall control.

Surface Preparation:

Prior to coating all substrates to be coated shall be cleaned in strict accordance with SSPC-SP1(Solvent Clean) using minimum 5000 psi. power washer with heated water to a minimum of 210F (Water Cleaning LP WC) to remove all deposits of oil, grease, chlorides, foreign matter and any other surface contaminant using a cleaning solution of Devprep 88. Do not allow cleaning solution to dry on the surface. Upon completion of proper cleaning of all substrates all areas with rust or corrosion shall be vapor blasted in accordance with SSPC-SP10 (Near White Metal) prior to coating system application. Blast media shall be crushed glass or garnet.

INDEMNIFICATION

The Contractor shall assume all liability for and shall indemnify and save harmless the State of Alabama and the Alabama State Port Authority, doing business as Alabama State Docks (ASD), and its officers and employees from all damages and liability for injury to any person or persons, and injury to or destruction of property, including the loss of use thereof, by reason of an accident or occurrence arising from operations under the contract, whether such operations are performed by himself or by any subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by either of them occurring on or about the premises, or the ways and means adjacent during the term of the contract, or any extension thereof, and shall also assume the liability for injury and/or damages to adjacent or neighboring property by reason of work done under the contract.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall not commence work under the contract until he has obtained all insurance required under the following paragraphs and until such insurance has been approved by ASD, nor shall the Contractor allow any subcontractor to commence work until all similar applicable insurance has been obtained by the subcontractor or the Contractor has provided coverage for the subcontractor. Each policy of insurance shall provide, either in body of the policy or by endorsement, that such policy cannot be substantially altered or cancelled without thirty (30) days' written notice to ASD and to the insured. Except for Workers Compensation, said policies will identify Alabama State Port Authority, its officers, officials, agents, servants and employees as Primary and Non-contributory Additional Insureds in connection with work performed for, on behalf of, or on the property of ASD including a waiver of all rights of subrogation.

General Liability (required for this project)

The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the contract Commercial General Liability insurance, including Blanket Contractual and Completed Operations coverages, in an amount not less than \$3,000,000 for any one occurrence for bodily injury, including death, and property damage liability.

NOTE Proof that coverage for overdraft (paint overspray/sandblasting) coverage is included must be provided in writing prior to commencement of work.

Automobile Liability

The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the contract Business Automobile Liability insurance covering <u>any auto</u> in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 for any one occurrence for bodily injury, including death, and property damage liability.

Workers Compensation (Alabama W/C and USLH coverage are required for this project)

The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the contract Workers Compensation and Employers Liability insurance providing coverage under the Alabama Workers Compensation Act in an amount not less than that required by Alabama law.
