Question Submitted	Is there vehicular access to both ends of the boardwalk?
ASPA Response	Yes. The north side of the boardwalk can be accessed by an unpaved road entrance to the Muddy Creek Wetland Mitigation Area off of Bowers Lane. The south side of the boardwalk can be accessed by an unpaved road entrance off of Industrial Road.

Question Submitted	What is the linear footage of the handrail?
ASPA Response	The handrail is an estimated 800 feet in length on both sides of the boardwalk, which totals to 1,600 linear feet.

Question Submitted	Must stainless steel deck screws be used?
ASPA Response	For the base bid, deck screws for use with treated lumber must be used. Please include the additional cost for stainless steel deck screws in the additive alternate for composite decking.
