Description of Work

This Requisition solicits proposals for demolition and disposal of a two story, timber and wood frame office building elevated on wood piers. The building footprint is approximately 7000 square feet located at the McDuffie Coal Terminal in Mobile, Alabama. The building is to be demolished and removed down to existing grade. Work will be in accordance with the requirements stated herein, attached sketches and specifications, attached insurance requirements, and applicable State of Alabama Laws. The work consists principally of providing bonds, labor, materials, equipment, insurance, and supervision necessary for the work described in this package.

All Contractors submitting bids are to carefully examine the site of the proposed work by appointment only and thoroughly review the contract requirements prior to submission of a bid proposal. Each Bidder shall satisfy oneself as to the character, quality, and quantities of work to be performed, and as to the requirements of the proposed contract. The submission of a proposal shall be proof that the bidding Contractor has made such examination and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in performing the work and as to the requirements of the proposed Contract. All bidding Contractors must hold the proper license from the State Licensing Board for General Contractors, Montgomery, Alabama.

An optional pre-bid meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, December 21, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. Meet in the Lobby of the International Trade Center (250 North Water Street, Mobile, AL). A site visit will be included.

The work performed under this contract shall not commence until the Contractor has submitted the following in an acceptable form: a Performance Bond, a Labor & Material Bond, and a Certificate of Insurance. Performance Bond shall be in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price; Labor & Material Bond equal to 100% of the contract price; and Certificate of Insurance shall be as per the attached requirements and countersigned by a licensed resident agent in the State of Alabama.

The Contractor will be required to complete the work under the Contract within 60 calendar days after receipt of a "Notice to Proceed". The work will have to be scheduled and performed in a manner that will not interfere with the operations of the facility. Work will start not later than 10 calendar days after receipt of notice to proceed. It is ASPA's intent is that work hours will be during normal day light hours.



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Description of Work continued

The Contractor shall comply with all Federal and State laws, local ordinances and regulations, and all orders and decrees of bodies or tribunals having any jurisdiction or authority, which in any manner affect those engaged or employed on the work, or which in any way affect the conduct of the work.

The Contractor shall place a competent superintendent on the Project who shall have experience in the work being performed under the Contract. The assigned superintendent shall have the responsibility for the day-to-day operations of the work and shall remain on the Project site while the work under the Contract is being performed.

Time is an essential element in the contract. As the prosecution of the work will inconvenience occupants of the facility and interfere with business, it is important that the work be pressed vigorously to completion. Also, the cost to the Alabama State Port Authority of the administration of the contract, supervision, inspection, and engineering will be increased as the time occupied in the work is lengthened. Therefore, exclusive of Sundays and national holidays, for each day that the work remains incomplete after the time specified, an amount of \$100.00 shall be paid by the contractor to the Alabama State Port Authority as liquidated damages for the loss sustained by the State because of failure of the contractor to complete the work within the specified time.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO BIDDERS REGARDING EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES: Effective October 1, 2011, the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act ("the Act") requires that any business entity contracting with or providing any grant or incentives to the state, including the Alabama State Port Authority, certify compliance with the Act. All Bidders must certify such compliance by executing the enclosed "Certificate of Compliance" and returning it to the Alabama State Port Authority with your bid package. In addition, the bidding company shall submit with their bid evidence that the company is enrolled in the E-Verify system. Sealed bid proposals can also be hand delivered from 9:45 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 5th, 2023, to the Alabama State Port Authority in the International Trade Center Killian Room, 250 North Water Street, 1st floor lobby, Mobile, AL. The official bid opening will be conducted in said International Trade Center Killian Room at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 5th, 2023. No faxed or electronic bids will be accepted. Sealed bids shall have the bidder's name, contractor's license number, project name, and time and date of bid opening shown on the outside.
- 2. A Bid Bond or Certified Check made payable to the Alabama State Port Authority and equal to five (5%) percent of the amount bid, not to exceed \$10,000, must accompany the Bid Proposal.
- 3. Authority reserves the right to refuse to issue a proposal form or a contract to a prospective bidder for any of the following reasons:
 - a) Failure to pay, or satisfactorily settle, all bills due for labor and materials on former contract in force with the Authority.
 - b) Contractor default under previous Contract with the Authority.
 - c) Proposal withdrawal or Bid Bond forfeiture on previous project with the Authority.
 - d) Unsatisfactory work on previous contract with the Authority.

DEMOLITION SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. Owner has attempted to provide the contractor with current as-built information including reference drawings. The Contractor is responsible for verifying the actual existing conditions and how those conditions may affect the required work prior to submitting his bid. Any discrepancies between the actual conditions and those depicted in said reference drawings shall be promptly brought to the attention of the Project Manager.
- 2. The work included under this contract shall consist of furnishing all labor, tools, equipment, materials, services, and supervision necessary for the demolition, removal from the site, and proper disposal of the subject office building inclusive of but not limited to all concrete, framing, utilities, furnishings and fixtures except as otherwise directed by the owner. Materials designated by the owner shall remain property of the owner and shall be safely stored as directed by the owner.

3. Applicable codes and standards:

ANSI/ASSP A10.6 (2016) Safety and Health Program Requirements for Demolition Operations National Demolition Association:

Demolition Safety Manual

4. Required Submittals:

Prior to commencement of work, the contractor shall submit to the owner proposed demolition and removal schedule, sequence of operations, and procedure.

5. Notification of Demolition and Disposal:

The contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State and Local rules and regulations including timely notification of demolition activity to regulators, including ADEM Form 496.

6. Protection of Existing Structures and Surrounding Areas:

The Contractor shall not damage or remove any object or structure other than the subject office building without the owner's prior approval. Contractor shall repair and restore all such damaged objects and structures to their condition prior to the commencement of work.

7. On-Going Owner Operations:

The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to prevent the interruption of utilities, communications, and safe, normal operation of the McDuffie Terminal.


8. Management of Demolition Waste:


- Contractor shall manage and dispose of all demolition waste in strict accordance with all applicable laws and regulations.

- Contractor shall be responsible for the proper selection and use of protective equipment for the work.


BEACH HOUSE AERIAL VIEWS









ALABAMA STATE PORT AUTHORITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACT WORK

INDEMNIFICATION

The Contractor shall assume all liability for and shall indemnify and save harmless the State of Alabama and the Alabama State Port Authority, doing business as Alabama State Docks (ASD), and its officers and employees from all damages and liability for injury to any person or persons, and injury to or destruction of property, including the loss of use thereof, by reason of an accident or occurrence arising from operations under the contract, whether such operations are performed by himself or by any subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by either of them occurring on or about the premises, or the ways and means adjacent during the term of the contract, or any extension thereof, and shall also assume the liability for injury and/or damages to adjacent or neighboring property by reason of work done under the contract.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall not commence work under the contract until he has obtained all insurance required under the following paragraphs and until such insurance has been approved by ASD, nor shall the Contractor allow any subcontractor to commence work until all similar applicable insurance has been obtained by the subcontractor or the Contractor has provided coverage for the subcontractor. The Contractor shall provide, at his expense, insurance in accordance with the following:

General Requirements (applicable to all policies)

All policies of insurance must be written with companies acceptable to ASD. The Contractor shall furnish to ASD certificates of insurance, signed by the licensed agent evidencing required coverages. ASD reserves the right to require certified copies of any and all policies. Each policy of insurance shall provide, either in body of the policy or by endorsement, that such policy cannot be substantially altered or cancelled without thirty (30) days' written notice to ASD and to the insured. Except for Workers Compensation, said policies will identify Alabama State Port Authority, its officers, officials, agents, servants and employees as Primary and Non-contributory Additional Insureds in connection with work performed for, on behalf of, or on the property of ASD including a waiver of all rights of subrogation.

General Liability (required for this project)

The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the contract Commercial General Liability insurance, including Blanket Contractual and Completed Operations coverages, in an amount not less than \$3,000,000 for any one occurrence for bodily injury, including death, and property damage liability.

NOTE Proof that coverage for overdraft (paint overspray/sandblasting) coverage is included must be provided in writing prior to commencement of work.

Automobile Liability

The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the contract Business Automobile Liability insurance covering <u>any auto</u> in an amount not less than \$1,000,000 for any one occurrence for bodily injury, including death, and property damage liability.

Workers Compensation (Alabama W/C and USLH coverage are required for this project)

The Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the contract Workers Compensation and Employers Liability insurance providing coverage under the Alabama Workers Compensation Act in an amount not less than that required by Alabama law.

Where applicable, Contractor shall take out and maintain during the life of the contract insurance providing coverage as required by Federal statute, including but not limited to U.S. Longshoremen and Harborworkers' Compensation Act (USL&H), Jones Act, and Railroad Federal Employers Liability Act (FELA).

WHO MUST SUBMIT A NOTIFICATION FORM?

Regulations require that someone (usually a contractor, property owner or consultant) submit a notification to the appropriate agency 10 weekdays prior to disturbing any regulated asbestos-containing material (RACM) or beginning demolition. Specifically, a notification must be submitted if one of the three following situations exists:

- 1. It is a renovation project and at least 260 linear feet or 160 square feet or 35 cubic feet of RACM is to be removed.
- 2. It is a demolition project with or without asbestos-containing material (ACM).
- 3. A structure is going to be burned for fire training (requires Departmental approval).

WHAT IS REGULATED ASBESTOS-CONTAINING MATERIAL?

RACM has greater than 1% asbestos by weight and includes friable and nonfriable forms. ("Friable" means that it can be crushed to powder by hand pressure.) RACM can include: (1) Friable ACM, such as pipe and elbow insulation, storage vessel insulation, and spray-applied applications such as fireproofing, soundproofing, or decoration. (2) Category I nonfriable ACM such as vinyl floor tile and mastic, asphalt roofing products, gaskets and packing which have become friable or will be subject to sanding, grinding, cutting or abrading. Please be aware that some older sheet vinyl (linoleum) has an asbestos-containing felt backing which can turn to powder (become friable) under certain circumstances. You must be careful with it. (3) Category II nonfriable ACM such as transite and cementitious siding or roofing which have a high probability of becoming crumbled, pulverized, or reduced to powder during renovation or demolition activities.

WHAT ARE SOME OTHER REGULATORY REQUIREMENTS?

A structure must be surveyed by an Alabama licensed inspector before renovation or demolition or burning for training. Friable and Category II nonfriable ACM must be removed from a structure before demolishing it. Category I nonfriable ACM can usually be 1 eft in the structure during demolition, if no materials are going to be recycled. Friable ACM must be wetted before, during and after removal until soaked through. It should be containerized while wet and properly labeled. Friable ACM must be disposed of as special waste, regardless of amount. Nonfriable ACM can usually be disposed of as general or construction waste. It is best to check with the landfill or waste hauler first. Removed Category II nonfriable ACM must be disposed of separately. RACM must be removed by an organization certified by the Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM). (NOTE: All ACM must be removed from a structure before burning for training.)

ARE THERE ANY EXEMPTIONS?

Privately owned residential buildings of 4 or less units that remain residential property are exempt from asbestos regulations, but they must comply with disposal regulations. (This residential exemption puts homeowners at risk!)

HOW ARE NOTIFICATIONS SUBMITTED?

Original notifications may be sent by U.S. Mail, special delivery service, hand-delivered or by e-mail (most common method). Revisions to notifications and courtesy notifications may be sent by facsimile transmission, but usually by e-mail. They must be sent to one of the 3 individuals/organizations below, depending upon the location of the renovation/demolition.
