The Docks Superintendent (Coal Terminal Option) is a permanent full-time merit position with the Alabama Port Authority in downtown Mobile, AL. This is highly responsible supervisory work involving the management of the import, export, and domestic cargo operations through one of the largest bulk cargo terminals in the US.

The Superintendent is the senior operations manager responsible for scheduling and managing a large unionized workforce and the bulk coal shipments to/from ocean vessels, barges and unit trains. Position is a direct report to the Terminal General Manager.

- Five (5) years of progressively responsible supervisory experience at a port terminal facility.
