The Alabama State Port Authority (ASPA) and the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) will host an open house Public Involvement Meeting for the Montgomery Intermodal Transfer Facility (ICTF) Project. This information will be used in the study process for preparing an Environmental Assessment to evaluate potential environmental impacts that may occur because of the project.
