Overview: Individuals in this role are responsible for diagnosing, troubleshooting, installing, maintaining, and repairing electrical systems, apparatus, fixtures, and electronic components of Port Authority bulk cargo handling equipment.

Key Responsibilities:

- Reading and interpreting electrical schematics and blueprints.
- Extensive knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions for electrical trades and high-voltage work.
- Proficiency in reading, interpreting, and comprehending schematics, engineering drawings, blueprints, operating manuals, manufacturer specifications, and sketches.
- Proficient knowledge of methods, practices, and materials within the industrial electrical trades.
- Perform multi-craft work, assisting millwrights and other personnel with non-electrical repairs, routine maintenance, and operational functions as needed.
- **Equipment Inspection and Diagnosis:**
 - Installing and maintaining electrical systems and equipment, including transformers, generators, switchgear, motors, and control systems.
 - Troubleshooting and repairing electrical problems, such as power outages, equipment malfunctions, etc.
 - Inspect and test electrical systems and equipment to meet safety and performance standards.
- **Documentation:**
 - Maintain records and documentation of electrical work performed.
 - Record findings from equipment inspections and diagnostic tests.
- **Safety Compliance:**
 - Ensure compliance with electrical codes and regulations.
 - Adhere to safety protocols and guidelines during all training activities.
 - Participate in safety training sessions and demonstrate a commitment to creating a safe working environment.
